



Tent Permit Process at Athletics

This process has been put in place to ensure that tents are properly placed in the spectator area in a way that the view of other spectators is not compromised. This still allows delegations the opportunity to bring their own tents/shades while being respectful of everyone's need to see the competition.

Tents will only be allowed:

- 1) on the very top rows of the spectator bleachers on the home side of the track and
- 2) in the designated grassy area as long as they do not cover the sidewalk.

Tents may only be placed if a tent permit has been secured. This can be done in a few ways:

- An online request can be completed. This will secure a "reserved" spot in the bleachers. These will be given on a first-come first-served basis and the number one certain delegation requests may be limited in order to allow more delegations space.
- A permit can be requested at the security tent on the day of the event. This on-site permit will allow tents to be set up in empty spots on the top rows of the bleachers or in the grassy area as space allows.

Any tents improperly placed will be handled as follows:

- 1) First a warning will be given to those with the tent.
- 2) Then the HOD will be contacted if the warning does not work. They will be given the opportunity to communicate with those who placed the tent.
- 3) The last resort will be intervention by on-site security and a \$300 fine for the local Special Olympics program associated with the owners of the tent.
