

# Softball Team

## Line-Up Card Information



Before each game, each team will be required to submit their official line-up card to the official/scorekeeper.

This line-up card is how the batting order will run for that game, and this batting order **must** be followed. Otherwise, the team can challenge and risk a loss/forfeiture of the game.

All players on the roster must be listed on the line-up card.

All players must play at least three (3) defensive outs or one (1) offensive at-bat. SONC preference is both.

The original 10 players may leave the game once and return. After the second removal from the game they cannot return a second time.

The position of your players is not permanent. Players can rotate in the field, but they **cannot rotate** in the batting order.

Subs can replace only one person in the line-up, but can go in twice.

Subs will replace the player in the batting order but does not have to replace them in the same field position.
