



Course Play Competition Information

- Check-in opens at 12:00 p.m.
- Tee Times begin at 1:00 p.m. Athletes and Unified partners should arrive to the course at least 30 minutes prior to their assigned tee time.
- Driving range, putting and chipping greens are open for warm-up at 12:00 p.m.
- Lunch will **NOT** be provided by SONC. There will be a local food truck at the course from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Local programs are encouraged to arrive early and eat lunch. Local program funds may be used for lunch. Make sure to inform your local coordinator about lunch costs.
- Men will play off the white tees, women off red.
- Adhere to local rules. A local rules sheet will be placed in the golf cart.
- Play according to the rules. If in doubt, play a provisional and mark that on your scorecard.
- Each Unified pair or caddie will have to sign off on the scorecard they were marking for before results are final. Make sure to then turn the scorecards in at the scoring tent upon completion of the round.
- **Golf Carts:** Athletes and Unified pairs will have assigned golf carts. Once you arrive to the course you will find the cart with your athlete's name/Unified pair on it. Carts will already have scorecards and pencils in place. Golf carts are **ONLY** for those that are competing and their caddie if applicable. Spectators are welcome to walk the course but must stay on the cart path.

Caddies

Your role as a caddie is very important. It is the same as caddies on the PGA and LPGA Tours. The USGA defines a Caddie as one who assists the player in accordance with the rules, which may include carrying or handling the player's clubs during play. **For complete USGA caddie rules refer to USGA Rules of Golf section 10.** In addition, caddies must be knowledgeable about the SOI official golf rules and SONC golf modifications.

At the end of every hole:

- Verbally agree to all scores with each athlete. Make sure to agree to the scorecard you are marking and your athletes scorecard.
- Carefully record scores on the official scorecard
- Know and use the 10x maximum score rule

Individual Skills Competition

- Individual Skills competition will begin at 1:15 p.m.
- Athletes will participate in two rounds of skills competition
