



### General

- Athletes are required to wear swimsuits which are within the guidelines prescribed by USA Swimming.
  - Referees have the authority to exclude any competitor whose swimsuit does not comply with USA Swimming guidelines.
- All relay teams must be in the same team attire. Suits must be the same color and if there is a team logo incorporated, all logos must be identical.
- Teams competing in relay events must wear swim caps of the same color with the team logo.
- SONC approved logos: The only logos that are approved to be on any part of the uniform (other than the apparel trademark) are the local program stacked logo or the local program shield (see examples).



### Swimwear

- SOI Swimming Rules Section 3.2.1: Swimwear must conform with the current FINA rules. An exception may be granted by the Technical Delegate/Meet Referee/Meet Director for medical, cultural, religious or modesty reasons. These exceptions should allow male and female swimmers to cover a greater part/parts of the body but all swimwear must be made of textile material. For competition all applications for an exception to FINA rule on swimwear must be submitted with the swimmers competition registration. It is recommended that lane lines marked at bottom of pool in accordance with FINA regulations.
- Suits should not be transparent, even when wet.
- Female athletes should wear a one-piece tank suit.

### Price range for full uniform

- High Price-Point: \$100
  - Includes suit or swim shorts with screen-printed logo along with logoed swim cap.
- Mid-Range Price Point: \$60-\$80
  - Includes suit or swim shorts with screen-printed logo along with swim cap.
- Budget-Minded Price Point: \$25-\$50
  - Includes suit or swim shorts with screen-printed logo.
